Points of note: This double CD is a collection of 32 tunes from Greg's first 5 albums, plus two new songs. Disc one is all live comedy songs and bits. Disc two is all studio tracks which vary from whimsical to celebratory, thoughtful, and heartfelt.

The live tracks were recorded over a period of six years in Kansas City at various venues. The studio songs were recorded over a period of 11 years in Nashville and Kansas City at multiple studios with many top-shelf musicians.

Greg Tamblyn has moved through careers as a singer/songwriter on the club circuit, to writing songs for Nashville publishers, to currently presenting humorous, offbeat, musical keynotes for organizations and events interested in a positive approach to life challenges. These include conferences of all kinds, associations, corporate settings, the military, and churches.
